## **Attorney Barbara P. Richardson Discusses Equine Legal Issues At Sho Clothes “Shop Talk”**

Richardson, who brought a wealth of knowledge to “Shop Talk,” discussed the importance of all parties being upfront and in agreement when dealing with the buying and selling of equines. She also discussed different types of agreements such as boarding, leasing, consignment, hauling and training.

“Shop Talk” is sponsored in part by the Gold Coast Dressage Association (GCDA) and the event is a great way for equestrians to gather and learn from top professionals in the equestrian industry. “Every month we learn new things and meet new people, and Barbara’s informative talk was a great example of how much we were all able to learn,” said Hundt, adding that the community response to “Shop Talk” is overwhelming. “It’s a wonderful way to enjoy an evening and also learn more about the dressage community around us.”

Sho Clothes is co-owned by Hundt, a former amateur dressage rider and accomplished art director, and Sell, a dressage rider who won a Gold Medal at the 1999 Pan American Games. Their Wellington boutique is a shopping destination for dressage riders from all over the world and they have been serving the dressage community since 2001. “Shop Talk is free and everyone is welcome,” Hundt said. “We meet on the second Tuesday of each month at Sho Clothes, 3220 Fairlane Farms Road in Wellington.”
