### **Courtney King-Dye and Grandioso III Win Sho Clothes Sponsored Intermediaire II at Wellington Classic Dressage CDI**

There isn't anything new the horse needs to learn, you are just perfecting everything."

King-Dye described the 16 hand PRE as "incredibly talented." A 1999 stallion, he was imported from Spain in 2003. Grandioso was the recipient of the Foundation for the Pure Spanish Horse's Open High Point Award for the PRE at the Palm Beach Derby last year.

"I feel very fortunate to have the time to develop him into a Grand Prix horse," King-Dye said, adding that she appreciated Sho Clothes sponsoring the Intermediaire II class.

"We were very pleased to present Courtney with the Sho Clothes scrim," said Betsy Rebar Sell, who co-owns Sho Clothes with Michele Hundt. "Courtney had great success all weekend, also winning classes with Don Principe and Atomic."
