Jan Brons Rides Away with Another Sho Clothes Whip at WEF Dressage Classic CDI-W

Wellington, FL - Jan Brons was all smiles after adding another Sho Clothes Whip to his collection after winning the FEI Prix St. Georges class during the 2009 WEF Dressage Classic CDI-W show.
